⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

QUESTION # 53: HOW WAS CHRIST EXALTED IN HIS ASCENSION?

ANSWER:

CHRIST WAS EXALTED IN HIS ASCENSION, IN THAT HAVING AFTER HIS RESURRECTION OFTEN APPEARED UNTO AND CONVERSED WITH HIS APOSTLES, SPEAKING TO THEM OF THE THINGS PERTAINING TO THE KINGDOM OF GOD,^A AND GIVING THEM COMMISSION TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO ALL NATIONS,^B FORTY DAYS AFTER HIS RESURRECTION, HE, IN OUR NATURE, AND AS OUR HEAD,^C TRIUMPHING OVER ENEMIES,^D VISIBLY WENT UP INTO THE HIGHEST HEAVENS, THERE TO RECEIVE GIFTS FOR MEN,^E TO RAISE UP OUR AFFECTIONS THITHER,^F AND TO PREPARE A PLACE FOR US,^G WHERE HIMSELF IS, AND SHALL CONTINUE TILL HIS SECOND COMING AT THE END OF THE WORLD.
