



"Lord Jesus, it is for you that I patiently endure this cruel death. Have mercy on my enemies."





"Desiring to hold to, believe, and to assert whatever is contained in them [The Scriptures] as long as I have breath in me."




Martin Luther 1483-1546

- 2. Huss stated that the authority of the Bible is higher than the authority of the church




Martin Luther 1483-1546



"Yea, if Christ Himself were again on earth and should preach, without all doubt, the pope would crucify Him again."






