Introduction: The good ol' days aren't always good ...

Context: Summary of discourse – Hebrews 8:1-6

Falling short of perfection – Hebrews 9:9-10, 7:11,18-19

The time of reformation has come – Hebrews 9:8-11

Greater worship - WHERE? - Hebrews 9:11

Greater Worship – HOW? By His Own Blood (12-14, 18-23)

Why did Jesus have to shed his own blood?

God required blood (Leviticus 17:11)

Under the law, almost everything is purified with blood (18-21)

Blood was also required for forgiveness (22-23)

Jesus's blood was required because of the imputation of our sin (Is 53:6, 2Co 5:21, 1Pt 2:24, John 1:29)

What was the value of the *Yom Kippor* animal sacrifices?
It is likened to the ashes of the red heifer (Numbers 19) *Kippor* (atonement) in the Old and New Testaments

AT-ONE-MENT – does *Kippor* infer reconciliation?

The EFFECT of Christ's blood (12, 14)

Eternal redemption from the slavery of sin (12)

Forgiveness – a purified conscience (14)

True worship & service (14)
