# The Test of Persecution

## Matthew 5:10–12

Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great; for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

2 Corinthians 13:5

John 15:18 If the world hates you, you know that <u>it has hated Me before</u> it hated you. 1 John 3:13 <u>Do not be surprised</u>, brethren, if the world hates you. 1 Peter 4:12 Beloved, <u>do not be surprised</u> at the fiery ordeal among you...as though some strange thing were happening to you.

### 2 Corinthians 4:17

*For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an <u>eternal weight of glory</u> far beyond all comparison. Hebrews 11:24–26* 

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, <u>considering the</u> <u>reproach of Christ greater riches</u> than the treasures of Egypt; for <u>he was looking to the reward</u>.

#### 1 Peter 4:14–16

If you are reviled <u>for the name of Christ</u>, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. Make sure that none of you suffers as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler; but if anyone suffers as a Christian, he is not to be ashamed, but is to glorify God in this name.
