I. We are seeking after righteous heads.

- A. Heads convinced of the law's perpetuity (5:17-19).
- B. Heads convinced of the law's spirituality (5:20-30).

II. We are seeking after righteous hearts.

- A. Hearts directed toward the law's performance (5:6).
- B. Hearts directed by the law's dynamic (5:43-48; 7:12).
- C. Hearts directed toward the law's reward (6:1-6, 16-18).

III. We are seeking after righteous hands.

- A. Hands devoted to the law's Giver (6:24).
- B. Hands devoted to the law's fulfillment (7:21-27).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What does *autonomy* mean and where do you see it in our world today? How is this third petition counter-cultural?
- 2. What is the difference between God's will of decree and God's will of desire? Which one is Jesus referring to here? How do you know?
- 3. Is God's law focused on external behavior or the heart? Why must we have both?
- 4. What is the proper heart motivation for doing the will of God?
- 5. Read Matt. 7:21-23. Why does Jesus tell people to depart from Him on judgment day? Why will the lawless not inherit the kingdom? Is this teaching salvation by works?
- 6. What might it actually look like to pray this petition for ourselves, our church, and our world?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. What is a potential error Reformed Christians can sometimes fall into regarding their thinking about God's law?
- 2. Do I have a heart inclined toward God's law? Do I love His commands and desire to do them?
- 3. Where am I most deficient when it comes to God's righteous will? My head? My heart? My hands? How can I be growing in holy obedience to my Lord?
