INTRODUCTION

- so incredibly hard to believe...but true!

- God chooses who will be saved

Rom. 9:1-18

- faith, human reason, and propositional truth

1. We do not possess the ability to affect our salvation (6:44)

- not permission, but ability

- universal inability

Eph. 2:1; Rom. 6:17, 20; Col. 1:21; Rom. 8:7; 5:10; 8:8;
1 Cor. 2:14; Jer. 13:23

2. God alone compels individuals to be saved. (6:44)

- *sine qua non* (without which, not)

- meaning of “draw”

Jn. 21:11; Acts 16:19

- God’s drastic, disruptive action

Ezk. 11:19; 36:26

3. To be saved, one must be taught by God (6:45-46)

Is. 54:13

4. To be saved, one must come to Christ (6:47-51)
