- 1. Let's Turn Back In Our Bibles:
  - To John 12 Where:
    - After Jesus Made His Triumphal Entry:
      - Into Jerusalem:
        - To The Welcome & Cheers:
          - Of Thousands Of His Fellow Jews!
  - We Come To:
    - Some Of The Final Words:
      - He Makes In This Final Week:
        - Of His Public Ministry!
- 2. Last Week:
  - We Heard The Message That Jesus Gave:
    - To Some Greeks:
      - Who Were Also In Jerusalem For The Passover:
        - And Who Wanted:
          - To See & Meet With Jesus!
  - And If They Would Just:
    - Listen To & Believe In:
      - His Message:
        - They Would Be Able To Meet With Him:
          - Not Just In Time:
            - But For All Eternity!
    - The Message They Received:
      - Is The Message:
        - We Need To Receive!
          - 12:26 "If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honor!"
- 3. Well As We Continue Through:
  - This Moving Chapter:
    - Jesus Continues To Speak Publically:
      - So That Anyone Around Him:
        - Might Hear Him!
    - Whether They Were Jews Or:
      - Whether They Were Gentiles!
  - And So We Will Pick Up:
    - From 12:27-34 "Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. / Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, [saying], I have both glorified [it], and will glorify [it] again. / The people therefore, that stood by, and heard [it], said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him. / Jesus answered and said, This voice came not because of me, but for your sakes. / Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. / And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me. / This he said, signifying what death he should die. / The people answered him, We have heard out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how sayest thou, The Son of man must be lifted up? who is this Son of man?"

        - And God As His Father!
  - And One Of The:
    - Main Features In This Relationship:
      - Is That Each One:
        - Sought For The Glory:
          - Of The Other!
    - That Is Both Jesus & His Father:

- Wanted The Other:
  - To Be Seen In:
    - His True Nature & Character:
      - Before All The World!

- 5. And This Is Why:
  - In 12:28 Jesus Said:
    - To His Father:
      - "Glorify Thy Name!"
  - Because This Is What Jesus Wanted Most:
    - Out Of His Life & Ministry!
      - Even As We Will See:
        - If It Led To His Death!
    - And Truly:
      - What Jesus Wanted Most:
        - Is What We Should Want Most:
          - In Our Lives!
      - That Even Through Us!
        - God Would Glorify:
          - His Name!
- 6. And So The First Thing We Come To:
  - In These Verses Is:
- 1. The Great Desire:
  - For God's Glory!
    - The Great Desire That Jesus Had:
      - For God, His Father:
        - To Be Glorified:
          - In This World & In His Life!
    - And This Is What We Find:
      - In 12:27a Where Jesus First Reveals:
  - The Struggle:
    - Of His Own Soul:
      - Since He Knew That:
        - His Hour Had Finally Come!
          - "Now Is My Soul Troubled!"
            - He Said!
      - The Word Translated:
        - "Trouble" Is Used Elsewhere:
          - For The Agitation Caused:
            - By Storms Or By Enemies!
    - And So After Spending Some Time:
      - Thinking About:
        - The Meaning Of This Hour:
          - And Its Purpose & Plan & Point & Promise:
            - That He Shared With Both His Disciples & The Greeks!
      - Those Thoughts:
        - Affected The Deepest Part:
          - Of Jesus Nature So That:
            - He Was "Troubled!"
      - Because He Knew That:
        - The Final Storm Clouds Of His Life & Ministry:
          - Where Gathering!
        - And His Spiritual Predators:
          - Where Starting To Encircle Him As Their Prey!
    - But Why Tell His Disciples This Now?
      - Perhaps It Was To Show Them That:
        - As The Last Hour Of His Life Progressed:
          - Nothing That He Was About To Face Would Move Him:

- From His Purpose!
- And That Nothing Would Matter:
  - To His Plan!
- But In Spite Of:
  - The Great Struggle & Trouble:
    - He Was Going Through:
      - They Would See:
- The Submission:
  - Of His Soul:
    - To The Will Of His Father:
      - Through It All!
  - Which Is Why:
    - In 12:27 Jesus Asked & Then Answered:
      - This Question "And What Shall I Say?"
        - That Is How Should He React To The Trouble He Felt?
  - Now There Would Have Been:
    - Plenty For Us To Say:
      - If We Knew What Jesus Knew:
        - About Our Struggles & Troubles In Life!
    - But Jesus Knew There Were Only:
      - Two Options For Him!
        - To Escape Them Or:
          - To Endure Them!
      - But Even Though:
        - There May Have Been Two Options Really:
          - There Was Only One Choice!
  - And So When It Came To:
    - To The Option Of Escape:
      - Jesus Would Not Make This Plea:
        - To His Father!
      - **IE:** Escape Room Goal Try To Get Out & Escape Get Hints If Too Tough For Jesus Not Even A Hint To Escape Here!
    - So Jesus Said His Thoughts:
      - Out Loud In The Rest Of 12:27:
        - "And what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour? But for this cause came I unto this hour!"
    - Jesus Knew That:
      - The Cause For His Coming:
        - Was Suffering That Would Lead To His Sacrifice!
      - And No Matter:
        - How Troubling This Would Be To Him:
          - He Would Not Seek To Escape It!
  - Instead What He Would Say:
    - That We Find In 12:28:
      - Would Reveal:
- The Seeking:
  - Of His Soul!
    - Which He Said In A Prayer:
      - "Father, Glorify Thy Name!"
  - And This Was:
    - Jesus' Greatest Desire:
      - In The Face Of All:
        - The Pressures & Struggles & Troubles:
          - Of His Soul!
    - Jesus Wanted:
      - The Name Of His Father:
        - To Be Glorified:
          - Even In Such An Hour Of Darkness:

- Now What Did Jesus Mean By This?
  - Well First:
    - When It Comes To His Father's Name:
      - His Name Like So Many Other Names In The Bible:
        - Represents His Entire Nature & Character!
    - So His Father's Name:
      - Refers To God In All Of His Attributes!
    - So Everything That Makes Up God:
      - Is Included In The Father's Name!
- And Jesus' Greatest Desire Was For:
  - His Father To Glorify His Name!
    - Now The "Glory" Of God In The Bible:
      - Refers To The Visible Manifestation Of God's Attributes!
        - And When They Are All Put Together:
          - It Is Often Seen As Light!
    - But To "Glorify" God:
      - Means To Recognize That Glory!
        - To Be Able To See It & Respond To It!
- And So By Praying this Prayer:
  - Jesus Wanted His Father:
    - Even In His Final Hour!
  - To Reveal The Fulness Of His Glory:
    - As God The Father:
      - To Everyone & In Every Place! In Heaven & In Earth!
- What A Desire!
  - And What A Way To Pray!
    - Especially With Jesus Knowing:
      - What Was About To Come!
    - Because When It Comes To:
      - The Glory Of God:
        - Nothing Can Get In Its Way!
  - And Through His Prayer:
    - Those Who Come To & Believe In Jesus:
      - Can Start To Have The Same Desire:
        - For The Glory Of God:
          - In Their Own Lives & Through Their Own Circumstances!
  - But Then What We Find Next:
    - In 12:28 Is That:
      - The Father Answers The Prayer:
        - Of His Son!
      - Even In An:
        - Open & Audible Way!
          - And This Shows Us:
- 2. The Great Determination:
  - Of God's Glory!
    - The Great Determination That God Has:
      - To Glorify His Name:
        - In Everything In This World!
    - And So In 12:28b John Tells Us That:
      - "Then came there a voice from heaven, [saying], I have both glorified [it], and will glorify [it] again!"
        - So Jesus Prayed To His Father:
          - In Heaven And Received An Answer Immediately:
            - From Heaven!
      - And His Father's Answer Is:
        - In Two Parts!

- The First Part: - Has To Do With: - The Past Display: - Of God's Glory! - "I Have Glorified It!" - The Father Says! - "I Have Glorified My Name Already!" - He Implies! - And - This Shows That: - God The Father Answered: - Jesus' Prayer: - Even Before It Was Asked! - But - How Has God: - Glorified His Name - And: - Revealed Himself Already: - To This World? - Well - God Revealed His Glory: - First - In Creation! - What He Made: - By His Own Voice & Through His Own Word! - Isn't This What We Are Told: - In Psalm 19:1-3? - "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. / Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. / [There is] no speech nor language, [where] their voice is not heard!" - May The Lord Open Our Eyes: - To See His Glory More: - In The Creation He Has Made! - But Also - God Revealed His Glory: - In Christ - Himself! - In The Birth & Life: - Of His Eternal Son: - Jesus Christ! - In Hebrews 1:3 - We Are Even Told That: - Jesus Is "The Brightness Of His Glory, And The Express Image Of His Person!" - Which Means That All That The Father Is - Jesus Is! - Yet, In His Own Person! - And In 2 Corinthians 4:6 - We Are Told That: - "God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to [give] the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ!" - So - It Is Jesus Who Reveals To Us The Glory Of God: - In All Of Its Fulness! - After All - According To Colossians 1:15: - Jesus Himself Is: - The Very "Image Of The Invisible God!" - And So - In Both Creation & In Christ: - God Has Revealed His Glory Already! - And - We Need To Pray That: - God Would Give Us The Eyes To See More Of His Glory: - In These Ways! - But Then - Also In Answer: - To Jesus' Prayer: - The Second Part: - Has To Do With: - The Future Display:

- Of God's Glory!

- Because - 12:28b - The Father Says:

- "I Have Both Glorified It, And Will Glorify It Again!"
  - So The Father Will Glorify His Name:
    - Yet Again!
      - A Promise That Points To A Future Revelation Of His Glory!
- Now Certainly God Will Reveal His Glory:
  - In The Consummation:
    - Of All Things That Will Come:
      - At The Very End Of This Creation!
  - In Revelation 21:23 When The New Heavens & The New Earth Are Established:
    - And The New Jerusalem Comes Down Out Of Heaven We Are Told That:
      - "The city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb [is] the light thereof!"
  - So The Fulness Of God's Glory:
    - Will Be Expressed & Experienced:
      - One Day Without Any Cloud Or Shadow To Veil It!
- But In The Context Of Jesus' Prayer:
  - God The Father Is Referring To:
    - Especially The Glory That He Will Reveal:
      - In The Cross!
  - Because In A Most Magnificent Way:
    - God Reveals The Fulness Of Every Attribute That He Possesses:
      - In This Final Hour:
        - Of Jesus' Life!
    - Such As His:
      - Truth (Promises & Prophesies Fulfilled), Righteousness, Love, Wrath, Mercy, Life, Light, Power, Wisdom, Holiness, Etc!
- And So God The Father:
  - Was As Determined As His Son:
    - To Glorify His Name And:
      - To Display All That He Is:
        - To This World!
  - Because From The Creation:
    - All The Way To The Consummation:
      - The Glory Of God:
        - Is Consistent!
    - His Glory Never:
      - Decreases Or Increases!
        - It Is The Same Glory:
          - Because It Is The Same God!
    - He Has Always Been And:
      - He Ever Will Be:
        - Glorious In All Of His Nature!
  - And There Is Nothing:
    - That Can Ever Get In The Way:
      - Of God's Glory!
    - And This Answer From Heaven:
      - Would Certainly Have Been:
        - A Great Comfort To Jesus!
  - And It Could Have Been:
    - A Great Confirmation About Jesus:
      - To Those Around Him That Day:
        - If They Had The Ears To Hear:
          - The Father's Answer To His Son!
  - But What Do We Find In 12:29?
    - "The people therefore, that stood by, and heard [it], said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him!"
      - Sadly So Many Of The People:
        - Did Not Hear Or Understand:

- These Words From Heaven! - Some Thought The Sound: - Was Just Thunder: - Rumbling Through The Sky: - From Some Unseen Storm Coming Up! - Others Thought They Heard Words: - But - They Were Just Words: - Of An Angel! - Not From God! - Whatever They Heard: - They Focused More On: - The Manner Of The Sound: - Than The Message & The Meaning! - And - May This Not Be True For Us Today! - We Need To Remember That: - God Is Still Determined To: - Glorify His Name: - In This World & In Our Lives! - No Matter What We Face! - And - As He Glorifies His Name: - Will We? Will You: - Glorify His Name As Well? - By Responding To His Glory As Jesus Did! - Remember - In 12:30 - Jesus Even Tells The Crowd: - "Jesus answered and said, This voice came not because of me, but for your sakes!" - Jesus Already Knew The Answer: - That His Father Would Send Him! - So - The Answer Was For: - Us - Not Him! - So That We Might: - See & Seek His Glory: - In All Things! - Even As Jesus Did! - But Then - After Jesus: - Expressed His Desire: - For God's Glory - And: - After The Father: - Revealed His Determination: - To Reveal His Glory! - We Then Can See: The Great Display: - The Great Display: - Through Jesus' Final Hour! - Which We Find In 12:31-33 - "Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. / And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me. / This he said, signifying what death he should die!" - In These Verses: - Jesus Reveals Three Ways:

> - That God's Glory Will Be Revealed: - In The Final Hour:

- "Now Is The Judgment Of This World!" - This Is An Ironic Statement:

- In His Life!

- Especially As We Know What Is To Come!

- Of God's Glory!

- First - The Decision:

- Against The World!

- Though The World: - Would Be Making Its Judgment About Christ: - In Just A Few Days Time: - In Reality - They Will Be Experiencing The Judgment Of God: - For Their Own Rebellion & Rejection Of Jesus! - And - When This Final Hour: - Of Jesus Life Would Come To Its End: - The Age-Old Question That Abraham Asked God Back In Genesis 18:25 Finds Its Answer! - The Question: - "Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?" - The Answer: - Always & Only! - And So - God's Final Judgment: - On The World: - Had Come In That Hour! - And - God Will Judge The World: - Based On How: - It Responds To His Son! - And - In This Way: - God's Glory Is Displayed! - Even In Judgment! - But Then: - Second - The Defeat: - Of The Devil: - Is Another Way: - God's Glory Was To Be Displayed: - In Jesus' Final Hour! - "Now Shall The Prince Of This World Be Cast Out!" - Which Means That: - Whatever Throne He Had: - In This World: - Will Be Taken From Him Forever! - And - The "Prince" Of This World: - Will Be Defeated & Dethroned: - By The King Of Kings! - Even His King! - And So - Through The Judgment: - Of Both The World & Its Prince: - God's Glory Will Be: - Fully Manifested: - For All To See! - But - It All Comes Through: - Third - The Death: - Of Christ! - Because - Even As God's Glory: - Through Judgment Is Being Revealed: - On The World & Its Prince: - At The Same Time - Jesus Adds - 12:32 - "And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me!" - So - Even In The Midst Of God's: - Wrath & Judgment: - He Remembers Mercy! - And That Mercy Is Found At The Cross Of Christ! - Even That Old Rugged, Roman Cross On Which He Would Be "Lifted Up!"

- We Know That Jesus Is Talking About His Death:
- Because Of What John Adds In:

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- 12:33 - "This he said, signifying what death he should die!"
        - But - Through The Cross:
                 - God Glorifies His Name Even More:
                         - By Using Death:
                                  - To Draw "All Men" To:
                                          - Jesus!
        - What A Mystery The Gospel Is!
                 - That Which Troubled Jesus:
                         - Would Turn To His Greatest Triumph!
        - So That Those Who:
                 - Are Troubled In Their Own Souls:
                         - On Account Of Their Own Struggles & Sin & Struggles With Sin:
                                  - May Find Triumph At Last By Turning To & Trusting In The One Who Hung
                                  On The Tree!
        - Now - We Know That:
                 - One Day - "All Men" - Will Be:
                         - Drawn To Christ:
                                  - As King!
                 - Because - As We Are Told In:
                         - Philippians 2 - Every Knee:
                                  - Shall Bow Before Him!
        - But - Today:
                 - "All Men" Can Be Drawn To Jesus:
                         - No Matter If They Are:
                                  - Jew Or Gentile!
                                  - Male Or Female!
                                  - Bond Or Free!
- And - In This Way:
        - And - In That Hour:
                 - The Glory Of God:
                         - Was On Full Display!
                                  - Have You Seen It?
                                  - Do You Believe It?
                                  - Are You Drawn To It - To Him?
                                          - More & More?
        - Remember - Nothing Can Get In The Way:
                 - Of God's Glory!
                         - But - Pray That Your Eyes:
                                  - Might Be Opened More & More To Its Display!
Otherwise - We See The Result Of:
- Those Who Are Blind To It:
        - In 12:34 - "The people answered him, We have heard out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how
        sayest thou, The Son of man must be lifted up? who is this Son of man?"
                 - They Just Couldn't Make Sense Of:
                         - What Jesus Said!
- So - What Kind Of "Son Of Man" Was:
        - The One He Was Talking About?
                 - One That Would Die:
                         - Instead Of Live Forever?
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2. It Seems At This Point:

- Those Who Welcomed Jesus:
  - As Their King At The Triumphal Entry:
    - Were Starting To Question:
      - His Credentials After All!
        - Which Would Lead To A Complete Reversal Of Their Opinion Of Him!
- 3. But Still - Nothing Could Get In The Way:

- Of God Displaying His Glory:
  - To The World Through His Son:
    - On The Cross!
- Which Is Why Paul:
  - Would Say Galatians 6:14:
    - "But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ!"
- 4. May Christ's Desire:
  - Be Our Desire:
    - To Behold More & More Of:
      - God's On Glory!
        - In Creation!
        - At The Consummation!
        - But Ultimately:
          - In Christ And:
            - At The Cross!
