Motives to Endure Suffering for Righteousness

1 Peter 3:18

I. Introduction:

A noble cause/person to suffer and die for

II. Exposition:

Christ's suffering as a motive for our suffering

- A. Christ the righteous one also suffered & died (v18a)
- B. Christ's suffering was to reconcile us to God (v18)
 - 1. Christ died for sin- "died once for sin" (v18b)
 - 2. His death was substitutionary- "the righteous for the unrighteous" (v18c)
 - 3. His death was all sufficient- "once for sin" (v18b)
 - 4. He did it to bring us to God- "that he might bring us to God" (v18c)

III. Application:

- 1. Arm yourself with the mind of Christ when it comes to suffering (4:1)
- 2. Pray that as a church we would be able to endure suffering
- 3. We are conquerors in the midst of our suffering (Rom 8:35-37)
