

Review : In part one, we saw God's charge of apostasy: "*my people have committed two evils*".

(1) *They have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters,*

(2) *and hewed out broken cisterns, that can hold no water.* Jeremiah 2:13

In part two, we see the impudent, audacity of the backslidden apostates (v 35).

21st century Christians treat God no different than the Jews of Jeremiah's day.

*I have not sinned* - "I'm under grace, not under law" **Romans 6:15, 7:14 & 25**

v 36 *ashamed of Egypt* ~ corrupt manuscripts & their modern perversions

*ashamed of Assyria* ~ seducing spirits of men & devils

v 37 *the Lord hath rejected thy confidences* **Jeremiah 5:10**
