

## ***“A Covenant Youth Called into Service”***

**Isaiah 6:1-10**

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How one is fitted for service to God

### **1. God Reveals Himself**

**vv. 1-4**

**(1) He graciously “calls” Isaiah into worship – setting him in His presence.**

- The time

**(2) He reveals Himself to Isaiah through vision and word.**

-1- The Vision

- The LORD, sitting on a throne
- The worshiping seraphim
  - \*privilege
  - \*service
  - \*humility

-2- The Declaration or “preaching” of the seraphim *“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts;  
The whole earth is full of His glory!”*

- Wonderfully constrained to give expression to the truth
- The content
- The power

### **2. The Gospel is Ministered**

**vv. 5-7**

**(1) Isaiah is gripped with the reality of his sin and need (5)**

*“Woe is me,  
for I am undone...!”*

- His own sin
- The sin of the nation

**(2) God declares His grace and forgiveness, assuring His child (6-7)**

- The symbolism

- The word of assurance

### **3. God Calls and Commissions into Service**

**vv. 8-10**

**(1) The testimony of a messenger needed** *“Whom shall I send, And who will go for us?”*

**(2) Isaiah’s response**

*“Here am I! Send me!”*

- Having seen God, he has a new zeal

- Having seen himself and tasted grace, he now responds in the full integrity of his person

**(3) Isaiah commissioned (9-10)**
