

"But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you."



- It is easy to get distracted by the world& forget God




SECRET SIN

God is privy to our most secret sins




"Those sins which lie closest and are most secretly lurking in the heart, are as obvious and odious to God as those that are most openly written upon a man's forehead."
