
The story of Christ and the person of Christ go hand in hand. You cannot have one without the other.

Christianity is not something that is expressed only on Sundays from 10-12 PM, it is to be all of life.


Colossians

If a person is living in unrepentant sin, then their walk / life is revealing that they are not truly saved.






We must not assume that they know the gospel, or the basics of Christianity.








Series: Colossians

Sermon: Colossians 2:6-9

1. Paul uses the word "walk" three different times in Eph. 5: 1-21. Obviously, Paul is not talking about putting one foot in front of the other but is speaking of how the Christian is to live life. A. Read over this passage and list the ways in which a Christian is to walk.

2. Paul describes the Christian life/walk as all consuming. Is there a temptation for professing Christians to seclude their Christianity to only certain times, places, or with certain people and to not see it as all-inclusive of their lives?

While we often see this in others, we must be careful to examine ourselves in this regard as well. Are there areas of your life where you could improve in your walk? Feel free to share or answer privately and reflect on later.

- 3. Has anyone ever tried to make you believe that Christ and the teaching of Christ was not enough? Perhaps they tried to impose their own arguments to have more authority than Christ or imposed current philosophies as having more authority. How would you respond to such a person?
- 4. How important is doctrine/sound Biblical teaching to empowering a Christian's walk. Has your walk improved as you have increased in the knowledge of the Person and work of Christ?
- 5. The Colossians 1:7 and 2:6 Paul speaks of the Colossians being taught the faith. Do we sometimes wrongly assume that non-Christians know all about Christianity, even though there is a good chance that they have not been taught? \_\_\_\_\_\_ How might realizing this better help you to navigate conversations with non-Christians?
