Prodigal Father: Extravagant Grace

A. Extravagant Grace Expressed!

- 1. "Put sandals on his feet"—the gift of SON-SHIP—Luke 15:22
- 2. "Bring the best robe and put it on him"—the gift of HONOR
 - a. Description of the "best" robe in that culture.
 - b. Put on before the son had a chance to bath—shield him from the disapproving gaze of his home town.
- 3. "Put a ring on his finger"—the gift of AUTHORITY
 - a. Signet ring gave the legal right of 'usufruct"
 - b. "*Usufruct*"—"use of the fruit"—the legal right to use someone else's property or assets freely and reap the benefits from them as if their own.
 - c. Father still owned it all—and therefore could make use of it

B. Extravagant Grace Questioned!

- 1. Fairness?? Doesn't seem fair to the elder son!
- 2. Sanity??? The father can't be in his right mind!

C. Extravagant Grace Explored:

- 1. God gives us the gift of **FORGIVENESS!**
- 2. God gives us the gift of **SONSHIP**—adopted into his family and elevated to the position of adult son. Galatians 4:4; 3:26; 4:7; Rom. 8:17. We are made an "heir of God and joint heir with Christ"
- 3. God gives us the gift of **HONOR**
 - a. BEFORE: clothed in the rags of our own sin and self-righteousness. Eph. 2:1-3; 4:15-16; Gal. 5:19-21; Isa. 64:6
 - b. AFTER: Clothed in the righteousness of Christ
- 4. God gives us the gift of **AUTHORITY**
 - a. Our "signet ring"—Spirit of God
 - b. By the Spirit we live, pray, and minister
 - c. The Spirit gives us authority to act as God's representatives

D. Extravagant Grace Celebrated: The PARTY!

- 1. The "fatted calf" celebrating not only the return of the son, but the extravagant grace of the father.
- 2. The heavenly party celebrating God's extravagant grace!
