Praxis

- 3. The Jews will continue to reject Jesus (as the Son sent from the Father) in John's gospel despite the ample testimonies which affirm His identity. What does this teach us about the nature of unbelief?
- 4. Thought Question: Why is it significant that Jesus presents all of His willing and working in connection to His Father who sent Him?
