

Rejecting Saul and Choosing David (2) 1 Samuel 16:1–7

God always chooses His man. God always accomplishes His will through the man He chooses.

The scenario is arranged by God - v. 2–5

- The Lord did not want David to rise to power through a civil war.
- The Lord arranged a secret meeting between Samuel and Jesse.
- Jesse was of the tribe of Judah, a descendant of Boaz, from Bethlehem.

The Lord refuses to choose by human standards - v. 6–10

- Samuel expected God to choose the most obviously qualified of Jesse's sons.
- God immediately differentiated His standard of choice.
- Eliab and his brothers were rejected like Saul (v. 1).

For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.

- People can only evaluate from a worldly perspective.
- By outward human measurement, Saul was not a failure as king 1 Samuel 15:19–21
- God's standard is not the outward trappings of human and worldly measurement.
- The Lord looks at the heart Genesis 16:13 Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, You-Are- the-God-Who-Sees; for she said, "Have I also here seen Him who sees me?"
- He examines the heart Hebrews 4:12–13 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.
- He tests the heart Proverbs 17:3 The refining pot is for silver and the furnace for gold, But the LORD tests the hearts. Proverbs 21:2 Every way of a man is right in his own eyes, But the LORD weighs the hearts.
- He knows the heart (God is the heart-knower) Psalm 139:23–24 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.
- The Lord transforms the heart Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

The Lord did not choose David because he had a heart for God.

The Lord chose David so that He give David a heart for God - **Psalm 27:8 When You said, "Seek My face," My heart said to You, "Your face, LORD, I will seek."**

Proverbs 3:5–6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.
