- 1. Jd 1:20-21; Rm 8:34-35a. Loved when love is growing cold [Mt 24:12].
- **2.** Love can be taken for granted or unrequited 2C 12:15; THB #142. God's love is the most unrequited of all loves.

## 1st: Experience the Refreshment of Christ's Love
