An analogy. Back in the late 1970's I was with my dad out on his property out in the country outside of La Grange, Texas. I was in our camp house and I stepped into the garage where I was met by an unhappy snake who was ready to strike. My dad told me to push the snake out on the gravel driveway where he would dispatch the snake with a single shot .22 rifle that my grandfather had given him back in the 1940's on his 14th birthday. Once I got the snake outside on the gravel driveway, the snake was completely exposed. Being exposed is not what a snake likes and it took off slithering as fast as it could go to get away and hide once more, however, my dad armed with his trusty one shot rifle that he had known so well for over 30 years at that time, took care of the snake with the one bullet he had with a direct hit right to the snake's head.

I've always been proud of my dad for that shot. I'm telling this old story as an analogy to a much older story as found in the Bible. Genesis 3:3-15,

1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden'?" 2 The woman said to the serpent, "From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; 3 but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die.'" 4 The serpent said

to the woman, "You surely will not die! 5 "For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate. 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings. 8 They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?" 10 He said, "I heard the sound of You in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself." 11 And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?" 12 The man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me from the tree, and I ate." 13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" And the woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate." 14 The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, Cursed are you more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you will go, And dust you will eat All the days of your life; 15 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel."

Now notice when it says, "He shall bruise you on the head," down there in the footnotes as we see for Genesis 3:15, it can also be considered the word "crush." So, "He shall crush you on the head." This is all coming from the New American Standard Bible in this citation.

The word of God is supreme over any so-called man-made "church" because God puts his word above his own name. As the Psalmist turns to the temple to worship, he writes in Psalm 138:2, "For You have magnified Your word above all Your name." God's word is his communication, his promise, the revelation of himself to his people. It is to be a lamp to our feet in a dark and fallen world. Without it, we would have no way to know God or how to do God's will. Throughout Scripture we have a consistent theme of the dichotomy of light versus darkness. The world we live in is darkness reserved for judgment. John the apostle in 1 John 1:5 tells us God is light. Light is God's very nature. It represents to us holiness and perfection. This is why we often read that a physical manifestation of God's glory is light or fire. Sin is associated with darkness and judgment. It implies imperfection and principally ignorance, sinfulness and misery.

Facts and Evidences

1. Genesis 1 states "God said," nine times. It's interesting in Genesis 3 where the serpent, the devil, actually questions, "hath God said?"

2. Malachi says, "Thus says the Lord," 23 times. God speaks from Genesis to Malachi."

3. The Lord spoke" appears 560 times in the first five books of the Bible alone.

4. Isaiah claimed his message came directly from God 40 times. Ezekiel claimed that his message came from God 60 times. Jeremiah claims his message came from God 100 times. At least 3,800 times in the Old Testament, "The Lord spoke" appears.

5. Jesus quoted from 24 Old Testament books alone. The quotes are still the same today. They have not been lost in transmission. Examples. Jesus believed Moses wrote the first five books of the Bible, Matthew 19:8-9; John 7:19; Mark 12:29-31. Jesus believed Isaiah was a prophet, that's found in Luke 4:17-21, cross reference that with Isaiah 61:1-2; Matthew 15:7-9, cross reference that with Isaiah 6:9. Jesus believed Daniel to be a prophet, Matthew 24:15; Mark 13:14. Jesus believed in the Adam and Eve account, Matthew 19:1-6. Jesus believed the great flood and Noah accounts, Matthew 24:37; Luke 17:26. Jesus believed the Sodom and Gomorrah accounts, Matthew 11:24; Luke 17:28-29. Jesus believed the accounts concerning Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, Luke 20:37; Matthew 22:32. Jesus believed in the Jonah and the great fish account, Matthew 12:39 and following. Jesus believed the Old Testament was the word of God, authoritative and without error, Matthew 23:35; Luke 24:27 and 44; Matthew 26:54; Luke 16:17; Luke 18:31; Luke 11:51; Luke 17:29 and also 32; Matthew 24:15, 34 and 18; Mark 12:26; John 6:31-32; also John 3:14. Jesus passed the same authority of the Old Testament to the New Testament, John 14:26; John 15:26-27; John 16:12-15. Jesus believed the Psalms were inspired by God, Luke 20:21-44; John 10:34, cross reference that with Psalm 82:6.

To summarize, Jesus simply believed the Bible was the word of God, Old Testament, New Testament, and anyone that doesn't believe in the Bible as the word of God, the inspired word of God, doesn't believe Jesus, and if they don't believe in Jesus, they cannot be saved.

Isaiah 55:10-11: "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven... 11 So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me empty, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it."

Psalm 138:2b, "for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name."

Matthew 15:3-9, "And thus you invalidate the word of God for the sake of your tradition." You can cross reference that to Matthew 22:31; Matthew 21:16, cross reference to Psalm 8:2 and Psalm 12:3.

Proverbs 30:5-6, "Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. Add thou not unto his words lest he reprove thee, and ye be found a liar."

New Testament writers referred to the Old Testament more than 1,000 times.

Romans 15:4, "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience [also can be considered endurance or steadfastness] and comfort of the scriptures might have hope."

Job 23:12, "Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips. I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food."

2 Peter 1:19, "a more sure word."

2 Peter 3:5 and 7, "...by the word of God; by the same word."

1 Corinthians 14:37, "If any man think himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord." Cross reference that with 1 Corinthians 2.

2 Timothy 3:15-17, "and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

2 Peter 1:19-21, "And we have the word of the prophets made more certain and you will do well to pay attention to it as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation for prophecy never had its origin in the will of man but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." You can cross reference that with 2 Peter 1:16.

Isaiah 40:8, "The grass withers and the flowers fall but the word of our God stands forever." Cross reference that with Matthew 24:35 and Psalm 119, also 1 Peter 1:24.

Hebrews 1:1-2, "In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various places, but in these days he has spoken to us by his Son whom he appointed heir of all things and through him he made the universe."

Psalm 119:105, "Thy word is lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

Hebrews 4:12, "For the word of God is quick and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." Cross reference that with John 10. Scripture cannot be broken.

John 5:39-47, "Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life... For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?" Cross reference that to Luke 16:28-31.

Luke 11:28, "But he," Jesus, "said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God and keep it." Cross reference that to Matthew 4:4-11 and Luke 4:2-13.

John 8:47, "He that is of God heareth God's word, ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God." Cross reference that with John 14:21-24.

Matthew 22:29, "Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err not knowing the scriptures nor the power of God." Cross reference that to Mark 12:24.

Acts 17:11, "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind and searched the scriptures daily whether those things were so."

Acts 18:24, 28, "And a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man and mighty in the scriptures, came from Ephesus for he mightily convinced the Jews and that publicly, showing by the scriptures that Jesus was Christ." Cross reference that with Acts 13:14-15, 20, 27, 41, 44, 46 and 48.

Matthew 5:17-18, "Think not that I come to destroy the law or the prophets, but to fulfill. Til heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law til all be fulfilled.

Luke 16:28-31, "For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead." That shows the incredible importance of the word of God over even in the event of someone rising from the dead.

We see today's church is in the same place Israel was numerous times. "Then the boy Samuel ministered to the Lord before Eli and the word of the Lord was rare in those days. There was no widespread revelation." 1 Samuel 3:1. Do we really grasp what we have in our hands today? We have the final and complete revelation of what God has spoken in our hands. People died so we could have this book. So many Bibles and too few readers, and even less who understand. I think it's time for a change. Let's get back to what is called "the word of truth." 2 Timothy 2:15, "The scripture of truth." Daniel 10:21, "The word of life." 1 John 1:1, "When we walk in the light of his word, then we will have victory over the world." In Luke 11:28, the people blessed Jesus' mother for bearing him and he responded, "More than that, blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it." Let's all be blessed.

What is the main weapon that God has given to his people to fight and crush the devil? Answer: his written word as found in the Bible. By the way here, our viewers at home can see it on their screen as we go by page by page, but if they'd like to read it, just freeze frame each page, read it and go on to the next page, freeze frame that, and so forth, and

It's plain to see from the references given in this video presentation that unless a person believes what the Bible teaches and proclaims, they are either reprobate, heathen or hypocritical false professors claiming to be Christians when they are not. At the time of this video recording, a survey, actually two surveys came out revealing that 36% of Americans believe the Bible is true and here's what the article said.

"Two new surveys have revealed what Americans believe about the Bible and how often they read it.

The two surveys were conducted by the Barna Group and the American Bible Society and by LifeWay Research, respectively, according to Relevant Magazine.

The Barna/American Bible Society study revealed that the number of Americans who read the Bible regularly and the number of Americans who are skeptical of the Bible has begun to stabilize after the amount of skeptics increased and the amount of regular Bible readers decreased in 2011.

Now, in 2017, the survey found that Americans who are "friendly" with the Bible (defined as engaged with it regularly but less than four times a week) has increased to 38 percent, while those who are skeptical of the Bible and see it as "just another book of teachings written by men" has decreased to 19 percent.

The Barna/American Bible Society survey also found that the older someone is, the more likely they are to regularly engage with the Bible. Millennials were found to be the least engaged with the Bible.

The LifeWay survey also revealed interesting results. This study found that over a third of Americans found the Bible helpful (37 percent), life-changing (35 percent), and true (36 percent). A majority even said they believe the Bible is a good measure of morality."

Romans 3:4, "Let God be true though every one were a liar. As it is written, that you may be justified in your words and prevail when you are judged." Fake Christians and heathen unbelievers are unable to believe the Bible and thus they will be cursed on the last day along with the devil. Revelation 20.

John 14:6 is what we should all remember based on what Jesus himself said. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No man comes to the Father except by me." And Jesus said you can believe what the word of God says.
