### PLEASURES: MISERABLE ADDICTIONS!

TEXT: Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.

"The English word hedonic comes originally from the ancient Greek for pleasure (ἡ δονή; in Latin script: hédoné), in turn derived from the word for 'sweet' (ἡ δύς, or hēdús)." (Neuron. 2015 May 6)

"...dopamine systems clearly do play an important role in reward, but that role may not be as hedonic as once thought...today relatively few neuroscientists who study dopamine in reward appear to assert in print that dopamine causes pleasure...Even original proponents are no longer so enthusiastic... Evidence began to emerge that loss of dopamine doesn't necessarily reduce pleasure after all...dopamine stimulations do not reliably cause pleasure...

The intensity of dopamine NAc surges even when evoked by addictive drugs (e.g., amphetamine)...correlates much better with wanting ratings (Evans et al., 2006; Leyton et al., 2002)...Examples of 'wanting'-without-'liking'...Those intense motivations range from gambling to shopping, pornography, internet, hobbies, addictive drugs, or taking excessive medication in addictive fashion (Callesen et al., 2013; Friedman and Chang, 2013; Ondo and Lai, 2008; Politis et al., 2013). Yet these cases typically do not report intense pleasure..." (Neuron. 2015 May 6)

"Digital Addictions Are Drowning Us in Dopamine...Rising rates of depression and anxiety in wealthy countries like the U.S. may be a result of our brains getting hooked on the neurotransmitter associated with pleasure...A patient of mine, a bright and thoughtful young man in his early 20s, came to see me for debilitating anxiety and depression. He had dropped out of college and was living with his parents. He was vaguely contemplating suicide. He was also playing videogames most of every day and late into every night...

Twenty years ago the first thing I would have done for a patient like this was prescribe an antidepressant. Today I recommended something altogether different: a dopamine fast. I suggested that he abstain from all screens, including videogames...Their problem isn't trauma, social dislocation or poverty. It's too much dopamine, a chemical produced in the brain that functions as a neurotransmitter, associated with feelings of pleasure and reward...pleasure and pain are processed in the same parts of the brain and that the brain tries hard to keep them in balance...

As soon as dopamine is released, the brain adapts to it by reducing or 'downregulating' the number of dopamine receptors that are stimulated. This causes the brain to level out by tipping to the side of pain, which is why pleasure is usually followed by a feeling of hangover or comedown...there's a natural tendency to counteract it by going back to the source of pleasure for another dose..."

#### BBC, Aug. 18, 2021:

"What happens to your brain when you give up sugar... Dopamine is a neurotransmitter, meaning it's a chemical that passes messages between nerves in the brain. When we're exposed to a rewarding stimulus, the brain responds by releasing dopamine - which is why it's often called the 'reward' chemical...Dopamine can drive us to seek food, such as junk food...

Experiments in both animals and people have shown how profoundly sugar activates these reward pathways...[it] surpasses even cocaine in terms of the internal reward it triggers...its effects are independent of the sweet taste...In rats, there's strong evidence to suggest that sucrose consumption can actually change the structures in the brain that dopamine activates as well as altering emotional processing and modifying behaviour in both animals and humans...research in animals has demonstrated that the effects of sugar addiction, withdrawal and relapse are similar to those of drugs..."
