REVIEWING MARK 1–2

Mark 1:1–39

Jesus is the Son of God who came to destroy Satan. Anyone who wants to experience life without the curse must repent of their self-centeredness and follow Jesus through suffering to glory.

Mark 1:40 – 2:17

Jesus loves to forgive. He's willing to forgive sins, he has the authority to forgive sins, and the whole purpose of his mission was to forgive sins.
