THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE SECOND COMMANDMENT ARE, THE RECEIVING, OBSERVING, AND KEEPING PURE AND ENTIRE, ALL SUCH RELIGIOUS WORSHIP AND ORDINANCES AS GOD HATH INSTITUTED IN HIS WORD;<sup>A</sup> PARTICULARLY PRAYER AND THANKSGIVING IN THE NAME OF CHRIST;<sup>B</sup> THE READING, PREACHING, AND HEARING OF THE WORD;<sup>C</sup> THE ADMINISTRATION AND RECEIVING OF THE SACRAMENTS;<sup>D</sup> CHURCH GOVERNMENT AND DISCIPLINE;<sup>E</sup> THE MINISTRY AND MAINTAINANCE THEREOF;<sup>F</sup> RELIGIOUS FASTING;<sup>G</sup> SWEARING BY THE NAME OF GOD,<sup>H</sup> AND VOWING UNTO HIM:<sup>I</sup> AS ALSO THE DISAPPROVING, DETESTING, OPPOSING, ALL FALSE WORSHIP;<sup>J</sup> AND, ACCORDING TO EACH ONE'S PLACE AND CALLING, REMOVING IT, AND ALL MONUMENTS OF IDOLATRY.<sup>K</sup>
