QUESTION # 108: WHAT ARE THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE SECOND COMMANDMENT?

ANSWER:

THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE SECOND COMMANDMENT ARE, THE RECEIVING, OBSERVING, AND KEEPING PURE AND ENTIRE, ALL SUCH RELIGIOUS WORSHIP AND ORDINANCES AS GOD HATH INSTITUTED IN HIS WORD;^A PARTICULARLY PRAYER AND THANKSGIVING IN THE NAME OF CHRIST;^B THE READING, PREACHING, AND HEARING OF THE WORD;^C THE ADMINISTRATION AND RECEIVING OF THE SACRAMENTS;^D CHURCH GOVERNMENT AND DISCIPLINE;^E THE MINISTRY AND MAINTAINANCE THEREOF;^F RELIGIOUS FASTING;^G SWEARING BY THE NAME OF GOD,^H AND VOWING UNTO HIM!^I AS ALSO THE DISAPPROVING, DETESTING, OPPOSING, ALL FALSE WORSHIP;^J AND, ACCORDING TO EACH ONE'S PLACE AND CALLING, REMOVING IT, AND ALL MONUMENTS OF IDOLATRY.^K
