Differences between the Wise and Foolish sons Wise Son **Foolish Son** Takes care of household Divides/neglects a household Fears the Lord Hates God Is protected Is often disciplined Embraces hard work Shuns hard work Faithful and honest Liar Easily understands Cannot understand Has good friends Surrounds himself with fools Considers his ways **Deceives himself** Finds acceptance Mocks reconciliation Abundantly blessed family **Dysfunctional family** Thoughtful Naive Cautious Careless Disliked Has many friends Blessed through generosity Sins through hatred Finds love through goodness Goes astray through evil Works and reaps benefits Talks and reaps nothing Slow to anger **Ouick** temper Calm and confident Envious Honors the needy Insults the needy Safe in death Overthrown in death Exalted through righteousness Reproached through sin Finds favor from authority Finds wrath from authority 4.
