### **No God Like The Lord** Isaiah 44:1-23

1. **The people of God always have \_\_\_\_\_ to be encouraged because of who their God is and what He has promised.**

*“God is never so \_\_\_\_\_ with His church as not to leave some room for mercy.” - John Calvin*

- a. The Lord is committed to His people because He has chosen them to be His \_\_\_\_\_.
- b. The Lord promises to refresh His \_\_\_\_\_ people, from generation to generation, with outpourings of His Spirit.
- c. The people of the Lord need not live in \_\_\_\_\_ because there is no true God besides Him.

2. **Those who commit themselves to false \_\_\_\_\_ are acting foolishly and have reason to be fearful.**

- a. The worship of idols gives the feeling that one must have what they offer, but in reality they are of no \_\_\_\_\_ at all.

- b. It is right to take dominion over God’s creation, but it is idolatry to turn any part of His creation into an object of \_\_\_\_\_.
- c. When a person gives themselves over to idolatry, God gives them over to deception such that they cannot \_\_\_\_\_ the utter foolishness of what they are doing.

3. **The people of God must never forget the lurking danger of \_\_\_\_\_, while remembering the great privilege of being the Lord’s servant.**
