Our Merciful High Priest

In His incarnation, suffering and death, Jesus 1) destroyed Satan, 2) set us free from the fear of death, and 3) helps us when we are tempted. Hebrews 2:14-18

Introduction: Kierkegaard and the fear of death

Slavery and Deliverance

Exposition: Why did Jesus have to taste death?

Context: chapter 1 – the deity of the Son chapter 2 – the humanity of Jesus

- vs. 14 Jesus took hold of flesh and blood to destroy the devil's dominion
- vs. 15 to deliver us from slavery to the fear of death
- vs. 16 who are the "seed of Abraham?" (Gal 3:7, 29, Rom 9:6)
- vs. 17 He had to made like his brothers

 in every respect
 that he might be a merciful faithful high priest
 to make propitiation
- vs. 18 help in temptation

Application:

- 1. Christ empowers us to resist temptation (Romans 6:7-14).
- 2. Christians have no fear in death (1 Corinthians 15:50-56).
