Genesis 16:1-16

p. 4  A type is a divinely purposed illustration of some truth. The antitype (fulfillment) is usually found in the New Testament.

Here are some TYPES in Genesis 16:1-16

I. **Abram** - born again believer
(high father)
2 Cor. 5:17 cf. / Ps. 55:19

II. **Sarai** - still must experience new birth (21:2)
(my princess)
"born again" (3 ^{occurs} times) John 3:3, 7; 1 Pet. 1:23

III. **Hagar** - the world ("angel of the Lord" 1st occ.)
(a stranger, one that fears)
God doesn't speak to Abram for 13 years (Gen. 17:1)

IV. **Ishmael** - the product of the world's religion
(God that hears)
"antichrist" occurs 4 times (1 John 2:18, 22; 4:3; II John v. 7)
