

## **ARE YOU RESTING UNDER THE SHADOW OF THE ALMIGHTY? (PSALM 91)**

### **I. BACKGROUND INTRODUCTION TO PSALM 91 —GOD IS TENDER LOVE**

#### **A. Your Invitation to Trust the Lord (vs.1-2)**

1. God wants you \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ place (v.1)
  - *What is the secret place and how do we enter it?*
  - *What is the meaning of “Most High” (Elyon)?*
2. God wants you to respond by \_\_\_\_\_ under His shadow (v.1)
  - *What is the meaning of “the Almighty” (Sadday/Shaddai)?*

#### **B. Your Acceptance of the Lord (v.2)**

1. God wants you to respond by \_\_\_\_\_ in His security (v.2)
  - *What is the meaning of “LORD” (Yahweh)?*
  - *What is the meaning of “my God” (Elohay)?*
2. God is thus my \_\_\_\_\_, my \_\_\_\_\_, my \_\_\_\_\_, my \_\_\_\_\_  
(vs. 1-2)

### **II. THE PROMISE OF DIVINE PROTECTION (91:3-13) —GOD IS ALL POWERFUL**

#### **A. God will keep you from fear (vs.3-6)**

1. He will deliver you from the \_\_\_\_\_ of the fowler (bird catcher) and the deadly perilous  
\_\_\_\_\_ (v.3)
  - *Let us define our words*
  - *How does God do this?*
2. He will cover you with His \_\_\_\_\_ and under His \_\_\_\_\_ you shall take refuge.

#### **B. God will keep you from falling (vs.7-8)**

#### **C. God will keep you from failure (vs.9-13)**

1. God is in control when the Psalmist repeats for emphasis the words “\_\_\_\_\_” and “\_\_\_\_\_” ‘refuge and dwelling place’ (v.9)
2. God will not allow \_\_\_\_\_ to befall or harm you for He will give His \_\_\_\_\_ charge over you (vs.10-13, Prov.12:21, Ecc. 9:12)

### **III. YOU HAVE GOD’S PERSONAL GUARANTEE (91:14-16) —GOD IS FAITHFUL**

#### **A. The Lord confirms His promises to you (vs.14-16)**

1. God is speaking directly to the believer and \_\_\_\_\_ His promises to us (v.14)
2. God promises you \_\_\_\_\_ glorious blessings resulting in spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ now and forever (vs. 14-16)
