Hebrews 9:15-17

Introduction: Mediation today vs. the mediation of the priesthood

Context: Why so many messages in Hebrews?
The superiority of the new covenant – Hebrews 8:6-7

He is the Mediator (v 15)

Greek: *mesites* – of Christ in 1 Tim 2: 5, Heb 8:6, 9:15, 12:23
The mediator in the Old Testament (Job 9:33)

Of the new covenant (v 15-17)

The nature of covenants in the Scripture
Creation, Adam, Noah, Abraham, Israel, Moses (Law), David
The new covenant – review Hebrews 8:7-12
A covenant or a last will and testament? (v 16-17)
The purpose of the new covenant:
So that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance
Assurance of inheritance – a major theme in Hebrews (Heb 6)
