- I. Many of the Nation Heard and Did Not Believe, But God Is Faithful (10:16-21)
 - A. Not all have believed the report...
 - B. Isaiah 53
 - C. Faith comes by hearing, and hearing the word of Christ
 - D. Without excuse
 - E. The gospel was received by those that did not seek it.
 - F. God reached out His hand, all day long...
- II. A Remnant, Not Rejection (11:1-5)
 - A. God has not rejected His people
 - B. The story of Elijah – a faithful remnant remains
 - C. God's gracious choice keeps a remnant
- III. Salvation Is By The Grace of God, Not The Works of Man (11:6-10)
 - A. Grace is not grace if man works for salvation
 - B. The seekers did not find – the chosen received – the rest were hardened
 - C. Why? The Sovereign work of God
 - D. God is persistent, in both His command to repent, His drawing in of His people, and His hardening of the outcast
