Abiding in God and Loving the Brethren

Sermon 12 in the 1 John Series

1 John 4:14-21

Last week we looked again at the first 6 verses – only read verses 7-12, and settled in on the work of the Spirit in verse 13. We saw 5 aspects of the Spirit's work from John 16.

- 1. The Holy Spirit is another Paraklete. John 14:16
- 2. He acts as "the Spirit of Truth" 16:12-13a
- 3. He guides believers into "all truth" that needs to be properly understood.
- 4. He does not speak of Himself (on His own authority), but He speaks what He has heard 16:13b
- 5. He glorifies Christ 16:14

I. v. 14

- A. We have seen and Testify
- B. Savior of the World

This describes His mission This is what He came to do – to save. John 3:16-18.

II. V. 15 -- This is a further elaboration on 4:2.

To confess that Jesus is the Son of God is to affirm all that John has said about Him - and all the Bible says about Him.

And note the connection with "abiding in Him" in v. 13 and this verse.

III. V. 16

- A. We have come to know and believe... HOW?
 - 1. Through the testimony of the Spirit v. 13
 - 2. Through the authority of the Apostles (we) who were eyewitnesses v. 14
 - 3. Through the testimony of the church (among us -- whoever confesses) v. 9, 15
- B. Two aspects of "abiding in love" are in view here.
 - 1. To continue to love God and refuse to believe the Devil's lies.
 - One abiding in love can be assured God abides with him or her. This is the reason for v. 11 – and a reason love for the brethren is vital.

IV. V.17

A, Love to God – God's love to us – and love for the brethren. **v. 16b- 17a** is a short recap of verses **7-12**.

B. Confidence in the Day of Judgment. 4:17b

- 1. Our confidence is based on the loving relationship that has been given to us by God.
- This confidence is based on our relationship with God. 17c
 What we are now children of God 3:2
- 17c -- Who was He in the world? The Son of God. Who are we in the world? Adopted children of God.

V. V. 18

Covered in our book study -- What does it mean to Fear the Lord? last Spring.

VI. V. 19

This is a family verse. It's for sons and daughters who have been adopted!

VII. V. 20-21

If our love for God is real – it will result in love for our brothers.

We need to ever keep **4:9-10** in our minds and hearts. Then we can make the confession of **4:16**.
