"Mere formal divorce does not annul actual marriage consummated by the physical union. Breaking that bond does annul it." (A.T. Robertson)

The Point of all this:

- 1. If you are married, stay married.
- 2. If you get a divorce because of fornication or abandonment by an unbelieving spouse, you are free to remarry.
- 3. If you have been divorced and remarried, you are NOT living in adultery. God recognizes your marriage as marriage. Stay married!
