What is the criteria?	Faithful belief	Unbelief
What are the results?	Good works rewarded	Eternal damnation in the Lake of Fire
Will there be equal treatment?	Each believer will be rewarded relative to his works, some with greater reward (1 Cor 3:11-15)	Each unbeliever will be condemned relative to his works, some with greater consequence (Rom 2:6; Rev 20:12-13; Lk 10:12, 14)
Will it be just?	No. Believers stand blameless because of Christ's righteousness and not their own (Rom 3:23; 4:22-25; 6:23)	Yes. Unbelievers stand guilty because of their sin and receive their due (Jn 3:18-20; Rom 1:18-23; Rom 3:23)
What should I do now?	Obey God faithfully!	Repent and believe!
