Canary Islands over 300 years ago:

"The air was so full of them, that I could not eat in my chamber without a candle; all the houses being full of them, ...it was a troublesome thing when a man went abroad to be hit on the face with those creatures, so that there was no opening one's mouth but some would get in.

Yet all this was nothing, for when we were to eat, these creatures gave us no respite; when we cut a bit of meat, we cut a locust with it; and when a man opened his mouth to put in a morsel, he was sure to chew one of them. I have seen them at night, when they sit to rest them, that the roads were four inches thick of them, one upon another..."

Exodus 10:7-10

Then **Pharaoh's servants** said to him, "How long shall this man be a snare to us? Let the men go, that they may serve the Lord their God. Do you not yet understand that Egypt is ruined?" So Moses and Aaron were brought back to Pharaoh. And he said to them, "Go, serve the Lord your God. But which ones are to go?" ... 10 But he said to them, "The Lord be with you, if ever I let you and your little ones go!

F. 9^{th} Darkness (Exodus 10:21-29)

"Re (Ra) was the Egyptian sun god ...closely connected to the Pharaoh, Egypt's king. While the king ruled earth, Re was the master of the universe so they were of the same nature and were in effect a mirror image of each other." http://www.touregypt.net/featurestories/re.htm

Exodus 10:23

They did not see one another, *nor did anyone rise from his place for three days*, <u>but</u> all the people of Israel had light where they lived.
