Ch. 11 - Proofs of God's faithfulness, by His Dealings with Israel

- 1) God's Dealings with Paul v. 1
- 2) God's Dealings with the Remnant of Israel- v. 2-6
- 3) God's Dealings with the Rest of Israel v. 7-32
 - a) THAT God is hardening Israel v. 7-10
 - 1. Israel still exists
 - 2. "The Rest" (v. 7) = Nation of Israel
 - 3. "Israel" has been "hardened" by God

Aside on Hardening

#1 - Meaning of "harden"

2 – God does harden individuals

- In General Rom 9:18
- Gentile Nations Exod 4-14, Deut 2:30, Josh 11:20, 1 Sam 2:25
- Israel Deut 29:4 (Rom 11:8); Josh 24:19 (Judg 2:10-11), Isa 6:9-10, 63:17
- In Jesus' Day Mark 6:52, 8:17; John 12:37-40
- Israel in the Present Day Rom 11:7,25

#3 – How hardening works (and doesn't)

- Providence / Concurrence –
 God works cooperatively with His creation to <u>cause / direct</u> their every act to accomplish His purposes in such a way that <u>men are fully responsible</u> and <u>God is free from sin</u>.

b) WHY God is hardening Israel - v. 11-16

- 1. Not to destroy them v. 11
- 2. To bless the Gentiles
 - v. 11 salvation has come to the Gentiles
 - v. 12 riches for the world / Gentiles
 - v. 15 reconciliation for the world
 - v. 15 life from the dead
- 3. To Makes Israel Jealous
