## **Glorify God Because He is All-Knowing (v.33)**

Glorify God Because He is All-Mighty (vv. 34-35)

Isa. 40:13-14 - Who has measured the Spirit of the LORD, or what man shows him his counsel? 14 Whom did he consult, and who made him understand? Who taught him the path of justice, and taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding?

Acts 17:25 - nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything. Glorify God Because He is All in All (v.36)

Glory to God Alone in Creation – Psa. 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

Glory to God Alone for His Name's Sake – Isa. 12:4 "Give thanks to the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the peoples, proclaim that his name is exalted.

 Glory to God Alone in the Son and His Cross – Jo. 17:1,5 "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, ...And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed. Heb. 2:10 - For it was fitting that he (Father), for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation(Son) perfect through suffering.

 Glory to God Alone in Judgment – 2 Thess. 1:9-10 9 They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might, 10 when he comes on that day to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed.....

**How Do We Glorify God?** 

Confess and Repent of Sin. - Bear Fruit.

Matt. 5:16 - 'Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.'
