**Revelation 10:8-11**

**I. Doctrine: All of God's Promises and Threats Have \_\_\_\_\_  
"Sweet" and "Sour" Dimensions to Them**

- A. –This Truth is Found in The \_\_\_\_\_ *Itself*; . . . ,  
(Rev. 10:8b)
- B. . . . And it is Manifest in *our* \_\_\_\_\_ Christian  
Lives *as well*, (Rev. 10:10)

**II. How God's Sweet and Sour Scroll \_\_\_\_\_ in and  
through us, Christ's Church, vv. 8-11**

- A. –The Lord " \_\_\_\_\_ " it To us, vv. 8-9
- B. –We \_\_\_\_\_ *its* Truth *Personally*, v. 10
- C. –We \_\_\_\_\_ *its* Messiah, *His* Gospel, and *His* Justice  
in *Full Measure*, v. 11

**III. Why the Sweet and Sour Scroll Concept is So \_\_\_\_\_  
For us in the True Church Today**

- A. –Because it Reminds us that \_\_\_\_\_ our Lord Jesus *Suf-*  
*fered*—and *that* For *our* Sins, (Matt. 26:44)
- B. –Because it Reminds us that Life in *This* \_\_\_\_\_ World  
is "*Checkered*"; and that Christ is our *Only* Perfection,  
(Jn. 11:23-26)

**Key Verse**—v. 10: "*And I took the little scroll from the hand of the angel and ate it. It was sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it my stomach was made bitter.*" (ESV)
