

Judas the Betrayer

John 13:18-30

Have you ever been betrayed? Have you ever been fooled by a false disciple? These verses show the dramatic story of the betrayal of Judas. It reveals that none of the disciples thought Judas was the betrayer. Therefore, we should not be surprised when it happens that a person you thought was a Christian becomes a betrayer. Further, involvement in Christianity and loving Christ can two very different things. But they can look the same. This is the last time in the Gospel of John, we encounter Judas with Jesus. Here we see four ways Jesus engages His betrayer among His disciples.

1. Jesus knows those He has chosen, v18
2. Jesus explains His motive, v19-20
3. Jesus is troubled in spirit, v21
4. Jesus engages His disciples perplexity, v22-25
5. Jesus unmaskes Judas, v26-27
