



EMOTIONAL PROVISION (OF HUSBANDS & FATHERS)

JOEY FAUST (8-3-22)

TEXT: Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.

Ephesians 5:28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

29 For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but **nourisheth and cherisheth** it, even as the Lord the church:

1 Timothy 5:8 But if any
provide not for his own, and
specially for those of his own

and is worse than an infidel.

**Bathsheba bowed with her
face to the earth, and **did**
reverence to the king...**

Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and **we gave them reverence:** shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

**1 Peter 3:2 While they behold
your chaste conversation
coupled with fear.**

**6 Even as Sara obeyed
Abraham, calling him lord...**
