## Thursday Night Bible Study 2023 The Golden Psalm: v. 113-120



## **The Trust of the Blessed**

This 15th stanza of the 119th Psalm is headed by the Hebrew letter *Samech*. This is the second of several distinct "s" letters in the Hebrew alphabet. The others are *zayin* (v. 49-56), *samech* (v. 113-120), *tzaddi* (v. 137-144), and *schin* (v. 161-168). The failure to enunciate these syllables correctly was on at least one occasion a \_\_\_\_\_ mistake (Jud. 12.1-6).

The letter *samech* is also used as a word *samech*. When used as a verb, it means to \_\_\_\_\_\_ up or take \_\_\_\_\_\_ of (v. 116).

In this section, there is a contrast between the evil that was pressing sorely upon David, and the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Truth—the Word of God. Truly, David describes the presence of God in terms of great safety: my \_\_\_\_\_\_ place (v. 114) and my \_\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 114). In this oppressive time, David was trusting the Word of God to \_\_\_\_\_\_ him (v.116).

The Whims of Men vs the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Truth (v. 113-114) - David exclaims his utter \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the vain thoughts that permeate the \_\_\_\_\_\_. These "vain thoughts" produced \_\_\_\_\_\_ that caused men to halt in pursuit of the Truth. Therefore, they had no source of sure hope. Like the d\_\_\_\_\_\_ minded man (James 1.8), they had no \_\_\_\_\_\_ at all. The blowing winds of false confidence caused them to place their hope in \_\_\_\_\_\_ greatness -only to be \_\_\_\_\_\_. David would place his hope in "Thy Word" (v. 115). 2) The Waywardness of Men vs the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Truth (v.115) - A great hindrance in the life of any believer is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ with which we \_\_\_\_\_\_. David proclaims boldly, DEPART! If the child of God would escape, they must \_\_\_\_\_\_ the evil one and his helpers steadfastly in the faith (I Pet. 5.9)

3) The Wantonness of Men vs the \_\_\_\_\_\_of Truth (v. 116-119) - The Psalmist prays that God would "uphold me" and then declares "hold thou me up." He recognizes that the only substance of truth is the Word of God. It alone produces \_\_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_\_, Men in their wickedness embrace the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the human mind. They will be trodden down. Their lying deceit will be made fully manifested. In that day, they will be put away like worthless \_\_\_\_\_\_. Then shall the believer have their final rest in Him.

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye are all become \_\_\_\_\_\_, behold, therefore I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem. (20) As they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt it; so will I gather you in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave you there, and melt you. (Ezek. 22.19-20)

4) The Wretchedness of Men vs the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Truth (v. 120) - Reflecting upon these things, David is gripped by the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God. He trembles in \_\_\_\_\_\_ and is \_\_\_\_\_\_. At a glimpse of the holy sovereignty of God which \_\_\_\_\_\_ sinner shall stand before, David expressed fear because of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God.
