Cursing and Swearing

- I. Current Definitions of Cursing and Swearing
 - -Cursing: the expression of a wish that misfortune, evil, or doom would befall someone or something; can also refer to the use of profane or obscene language
 - -Swearing: the taking of an oath or making a solemn declaration by some sacred being or object; can also refer to the use of profane oaths or profane language.
 - -"Secularized Cursing:" the thoughtless, careless use of God's name
