Gospel of John
[Jesus, the True Vine (Part 3) (John 15:1-8, 16)]

-Seventh and Final 'I AM' Saying": I am the true vine" (vs. 1, 5)
-Metaphor: vine = Jesus; vinedresser = the Father; branches = disciples
-OT Background: Israel = Vine (Ps. 80:8, 9, 12-18; Ezek. 17:5, 6; Hos. 10:1)
-Significance: Jesus and His people are the New Israel.
-Observations:  1) At the heart of Christian discipleship is spiritual union with Christ (v. 5).
2) The presence of spiritual fruit is the indispensable proof of spiritual union with Christ (v. 5).
3) The production of spiritual fruit hinges upon spiritual union with Christ (vs. 4, 5, 7; see also John 8:31; Col. 2:6).
4) The production of spiritual fruit occurs through the Father's pruning activity (v. 2; see also Mark 4:5, 6, 16, 17; 1 Pet. 1:6. 7).
5) The production of spiritual fruit glorifies the Father (vs. 7, 8; see also John 14:13).
Practical Lessons
1) Beware of growing weary and fainting under God's pruning knife.
2) Plead with God that He will make you to be an increasingly fruitful disciple of Jesus.
