Blamelessness In Christ Is The Identifying Mark Of Those Who Love Christ & The Brothers, (vs. 25-26)

## 25.1) Christ's Spirit In Us Transforms Our Thoughts & Prayers

"Brothers, Pray (Pres.Act.Impv) For Us"-1)"For we do not want you to be unaware, brothers, of the affliction we experienced in Asia. For we were so utterly burdened beyond our strength that we despaired of life itself. 2) Indeed, we felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead.

3) He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again.

<u>Message Directive</u>: Look to Christ for the salvation of your soul; ONLY in Him can you truly love & pray for your brothers & sisters in Christ.

"Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other." (Isaiah 45:22, ESV)

- 1) "I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, 2) to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf, that I may be delivered from the unbelievers in Judea, 3) and that my service for Jerusalem may be acceptable to the saints, 4) so that by God's will I may come to you with joy and be refreshed in your company. May the God of peace be with you all. Amen." (Romans 15:30–33, ESV)

- 4) Anything we hope to accomplish must be by the will of God and for the edifying of the body.

Let us then be true and faithful, Trusting, serving every day; Just one glimpse of Him in glory Will the toils of life repay.

When we all get to Heaven, What a day of rejoicing that will be! When we all see Jesus, We'll sing and shout the victory!
