


Humanism – Good without God

2 Timothy 3:2 For men shall be **lovers of their own selves**, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

 **Humanism** is a progressive philosophy of life that, without theism or other supernatural beliefs, affirms our ability and responsibility to lead ethical lives of personal fulfillment that aspire to the greater good. It supports the maximization of individual liberty and opportunity consonant with social and planetary responsibility. Humanism thus derives the goals of life from human need and interest rather than from theological or ideological abstractions, and asserts that humanity must take responsibility for its own destiny.

A 2021 survey conducted by the Cultural Research Center at Arizona Christian University.

According to this new survey, a shocking 43% of American Millennials (identified as those born between 1984–2002) “don’t know, care, or believe God exists.” Less than half (48%) hold to the “Golden Rule” of “treat others as you want them to treat you,” while nearly 4 in 10 (38%) give the green light to revenge, saying “you try to get even with people who have wronged you.”

The Religious Structure of Humanism

- A. **Their God: Human Beings.** (Hu is a name for God in Sufism. HU-man literally means God-man.)

Ge 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, **Yea, hath God said**, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? **Ge 3:5** For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and **ye shall be as gods, knowing** good and evil. Two of Satan’s greatest attacks against man are to cast doubt on God’s word and to allure through knowledge, thus elevating man as his own final authority.

It is common to hear phrases like this today: Celebrate life, Do life, Realize your potential, Self Esteem, Accept yourself, Have faith in yourself, Learn to live with yourself, etc. Taking the focus off God (**Jas.4:13-16**). Besides this, we indoctrinate our children with the “need to get an education”.

God’s View of Man

- B. Their Bible:** The Humanist Manifesto, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and Science
- Manifesto II:** “We believe...that traditional dogmatic or authoritarian religions that place revelation, God, ritual, or creed above human needs and experience do a disservice to the human species... We find insufficient evidence of a supernatural; it is either meaningless or irrelevant to the question of the survival and fulfillment of the human... While there is much we do not know, humans are responsible for what we are and what we become. “No deity will save us; we must save ourselves.”

- What they say about bible believers:** If the Humanist view of the Bible is correct, millions of Bible-believers and churchgoers are wasting much time, money, and energy. Moreover, because so many people have been told the Bible is the "Good Book," biblical teachings shape the attitudes of millions on numerous subjects. When the subjects involve governmental issues, all of society can be affected when Bible-believers express their views in the political arena.
- Science:** Humanists argue against the revival of creationism through “intelligent design” theories, as well as other inappropriate religious teachings in public schools and policymaking. Also pro-gay and pro-abortion.
- C. Their Preachers:** *Public educators, government workers, TV personalities, and many religious leaders.*
