
Missionary of the Month



A Man After God's Own Heart (2) 1 Samuel 13:14

The people made a choice - **1 Samuel 12:13** Saul made a choice - **1 Samuel 13:1–7** God made a choice - **1 Samuel 13:14**

The LORD has sought for Himself a man after His own heart,

- This verse is commonly understood to be saying that God is looking for someone who has a heart for God or a heart like God's heart.
- This expression is an idiom meaning that a person is making a choice of their own desire.
- The expression means that the Lord chose the man He wanted 2 Samuel 7:21 For Your word's sake, and according to Your own heart, You have done all these great things, to make Your servant know them.
- The Lord has always chosen His man (Abrham, Isaac, Jacob).
- The Lord has always chosen His own man to deliver His people 1 Samuel 12:1–12
- The man God chose was David Psalm 78:67–72

Jesus is God's chosen - Acts 13:16–23, 33–41

- Israel had a stubborn habit of rejecting God's chosen.
- God has chosen Christ and warns Israel not to reject Him.
- But there will be Gentiles who will receive Him Acts 13:42–48

The Lord chooses. We are either with Him or not.
