Summary: In the future, Jesus will call us (i.e. His bride, the church) up using His voice.

v 2 immediately - 55x in NT

English Lesson: 1. mediate, adj. def: interposed; intervening; between to objects or events.

2. immediate, adj. def: direct; proximate; instant; without the intervention of time or another.

Immediately is used in the gospels twenty-four times describing the work of Jesus.

Jesus touched him . . . and immediately his leprosy was cleansed. Matt 8:3

And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him. Matt 14:31

Jesus touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight. Matt 20:34

In Sum: The Rapture is an event that is an instant and direct work of our Lord Jesus Christ.

... I will come again, and will receive you unto myself.

John 14:3

For the Lord himself shall . . . descend . . . shout, with the voice 1 Thes 4:16

Hist: I was in the spirit - John experienced a prophetic type of the Rapture.

Dost: Raptured saints will be raised in a spiritual body. 1 Corinthians 15:44
