Amplification of Charles Spurgeon's Devotional *Light in Our Darkness**

- I. The Lord is *my* light and *my* salvation
 - A. Personal interest
 - B. No light within us, therefore He must shine light into our hearts
 - i. Ephesians 2:1-5
 - ii. Romans 8:5-8

- II. God in Christ is our Light; *He is Light!*
 - A. Light within us, around us, reflected from us, revealed to us - Ephesians 2:6-10; 1:22-23
 - B. He is the power of Light clothing us in His might; “whom shall I fear?” - Colossians 1:11-14

- III. The Lord is the defense/refuge/stronghold of my life
 - A. “...the real power of the omnipotent I AM.”
 - B. Boasting in God through our praise;
 - i. realizing our weakness shows His strength
 - ii. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

- IV. Whom shall I dread?!
 - A. All of our strength is from God
 - B. “...we cannot be weakened by all the cunning movements of our adversary.”
 - C. The present and the future
 - D. Romans 8:31-38
