



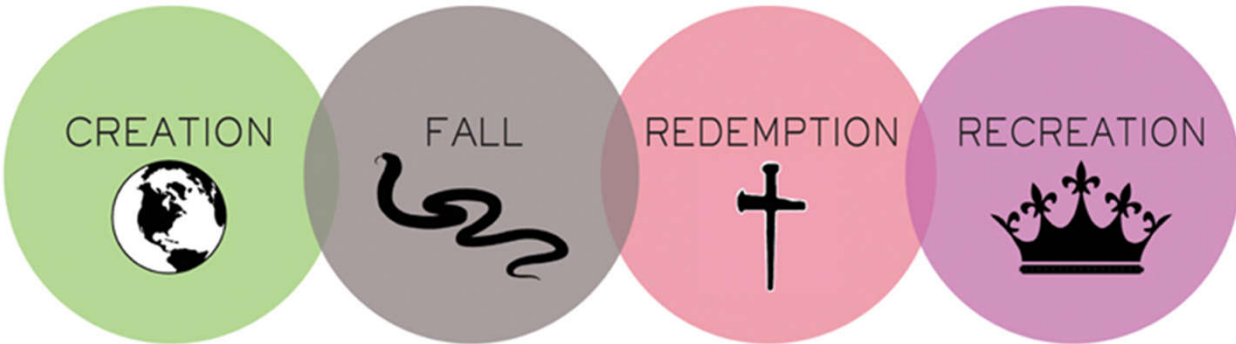

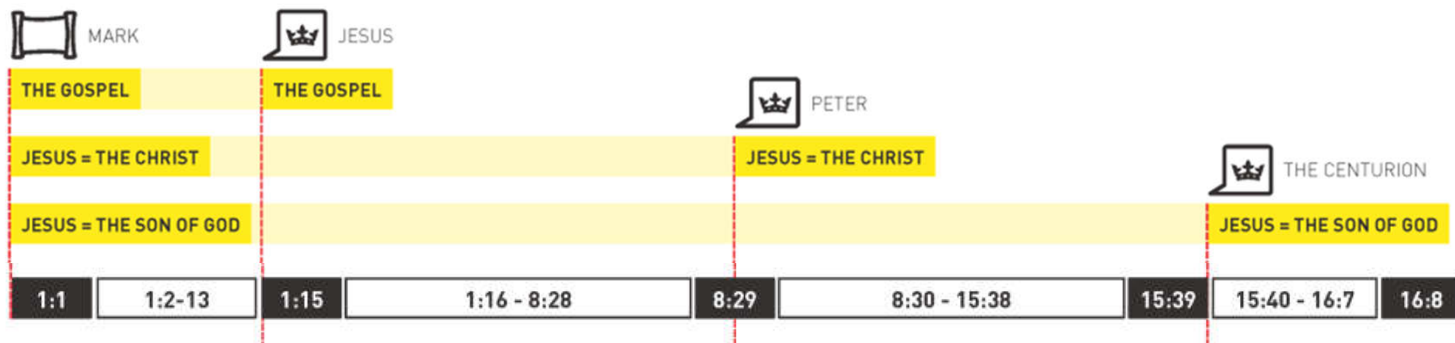

Arrival of the Son of God
