Acts 13 sets the tone for 2nd half of Acts, Like Acts 2 did for first half of Acts

A picture of how early Christians used the OT to substantiate the Gospel

I. Invitation (13:13-15)

A. Setting the stage and context

Perga Pamphylia: river port. Paul was the leader (Paul & his companions)

John Mark leaves group – no comment made until Acts 15:37-39 -negative

Paul asked to address Synagogue: Jews & Gentiles converts, God fearers

II. The Clear Message of the Old and New Testament (13:16-37)

- A. Gospel of Christ is the witness of the God of the Old Testament (17-23)
- B. Old Testament history climaxes in New Testament Christianity (24-31)
- C. Paul's Biblical defense of these unchangeable facts
 - ➤ Psalm 2:7 "You are My Son: today I have become your Father"
 - ➤ Isaiah 53:3 "I will give you the sure mercies of David"
 - ➤ Psalm 16: 10 "I will not allow My holy One to see corruption"
 - ➤ Hab 1:5 "you despisers, marvel & perish, for my work I will declare"

Through this man is preached the forgiveness of sins

By Him all who believe: justified from all things law can't justify you
