- Paul shows us how David is a shadow/ type of God's Servant Messiah
- David served his generation, he died & saw corruption, still in the grave
- Jesus, David's seed died and conquered death incorruptible life

## I. Jesus – the Long-Awaited Messiah, Deliverer, Savior

- Gen 12: 3 "and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed,"
- Gen 49: 10 "scepter shall not depart from Judah, until He comes..."
- 2 Sam 7:13-13 "I will set up your seed...establish His throne forever"
- Isaiah 9: 6-7 "unto us a child is born...His kingdom will last forever"
- Micah 5:2 "From Bethlehem, Ephrathah...come forth a ruler of Israel"
- Isaiah 53: 5-6 "bruised for our transgressions, His stripes heal us"
- Isaiah 53:12-13 "He bore the sins of many... see the travail of His soul"

## I. Jesus, God's Matchless Gift through the Ages

- Through this man is preached forgiveness of sins
- All who believe are justified from all things, law doesn't save Jesus does

## III. What Does that Really Mean to you? Jesus, Worthy of Our Trust

- 1. Trust Jesus: because you've sinned in Him you escape guilt & wrath
- 2. Trust Jesus: because no human morality can save you from your sin
- 3. Trust Jesus: because God spent centuries preparing to send Him for Sin
- 4. Trust Jesus: no mere man but God's Son: foundation of forgiveness
- 5. Trust Jesus: He rose from the dead, is alive now & will never die again
