

THE TRANSFIGURATION

Mark 9:1-13

Introduction: Seeing the Kingdom (1)

It is best to interpret this verse in context of what comes after it. The three disciples: Peter, James and John, saw Jesus in His glory and got a preview of the Kingdom seven days later.

I. Jesus Is Transfigured. (2-4)

Moses represents the Law and Elijah the Prophets. The Old Testament laid a foundation for Jesus Christ being revealed in the New Testament.

II. Peter Speaks (5-6)

III. God Speaks (7-8)

As the Old Testament Law (Moses) and Prophets (Elijah) fade away, what is left is Jesus Christ. All the Old Testament points towards Christ.

IV. Jesus Commands the Disciples to Keep Quiet. (9-10)

Why did the disciples question what Jesus meant by the resurrection from the dead?

V. The Coming of Elijah. (11-13)

This was fulfilled in John the Baptist who came in the spirit of Elijah.
