- Even As John Tells Us:
  - In 6:5 "When Jesus then lifted up his eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?"

- Like A Shepherd: - Jesus Saw These Sheep: - And - Once Again: - Had Compassion On Them! Because: - He Saw Their Great Number! - John & The Other Gospel Writers: - Tell Us That Jesus Saw: - A "Great Company" - Or - "Crowd!" - And - A Little Later: - John Told Us That The Number Of Men: - Who Were There: - Was About 5,000! - But - Matthew Tells Us That: - "They that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children!" (Matthew 14:21) - So - Some Have Estimated That: - There Could Have Been: - More Than 20,000 Persons In All: - In This "Great Company!" - That Is A Great & A Huge Number Of People! - And Yet - Jesus Saw Them: - And Had Compassion On Them: - Because They Were Like Sheep: - Without A Shepherd! - And - He Wanted Them To Know: - That He Was Their Shepherd! - Also: - He Saw Their Great Needs! - All Throughout That Day: - Jesus Ministered To: - Their Need Of Healing! - After All - This Is What Drew: - Many Of Those People To Him That Day! - And Many Still: - Needed His Touch Of Healing! - As Matthew Records - "And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them!" (Matthew 15:30) - But - Even After All That: - Jesus Now Sought To Minister To: - Their Need From Hunger! - By Providing Them Food! - So - Here - He Asked Philip: - Who Grew Up In That Area: - "Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?" - Like A Good Shepherd: - Jesus Saw This Great Crowd: - And Sought To Meet: - Their Greatest Needs! - And - This Is Still The Kind Of Shepherd: - Jesus Is! - But - Why Would He Do This? - In 6:3 - When Jesus Was Sitting:

    - In 6:11 "And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would!"
      - Like A Shepherd:

          - And Provided For Their Hunger!
  - In Mark's Account:
    - He Notes That Jesus:
      - "Commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass!" (Mark 6:39)
    - This Isn't Just A Reference:

        - Where The Miracle Occurred!
          - Or Even:
      - To The Period:
        - When The Miracle Occurred!
  - If Only The Crowd:
    - Could Have Seen Themselves:
      - In That Scene In Terms Of:
        - Psalm 23 "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. / He maketh me to lie down in green pastures!"
    - Jesus Was Their Shepherd!
      - And Jesus:
        - Was Their Lord!
          - And So He Served Them! He Served Them:

    - "When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. / Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten!"
  - This Is The Result Of The Miracle!
    - Not Only Was The Crowed:
      - Filled To The Full And:
        - Were Completely Satisfied!
    - Then The Disciples Actually:
      - Took Back In More:
        - Than They Gave Out!
  - And Those Leftovers:
    - Would Have Been Able To:
      - Be Shared With Others:
        - Who Needed Food!
    - 12 Baskets A Basket:
      - For Each Disciple:
        - To Share! But Even More:
          - A Sign!
    - 12 Baskets A Basket:
      - For Each Tribe Of Israel:
        - To Show His People That:
          - He Is The One Who "Satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness!" (Psalm 107:9)
  - Like A Good Shepherd / As The Good Shepherd:
